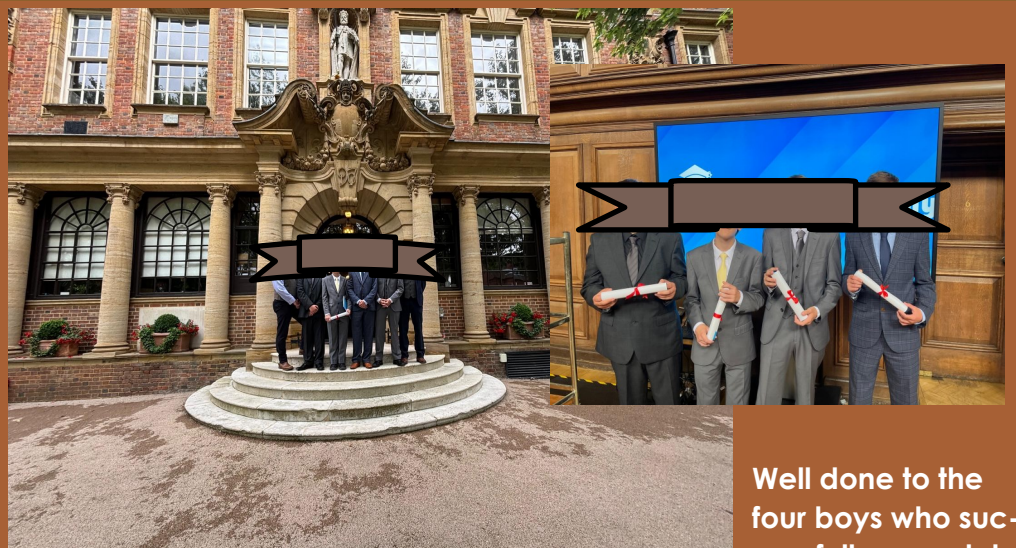

Biscoff Muffins made during cooking enrichment, the recipes were chosen by the pupils and have involved them using a range of skills, including folding, cutting, measuring and kneading

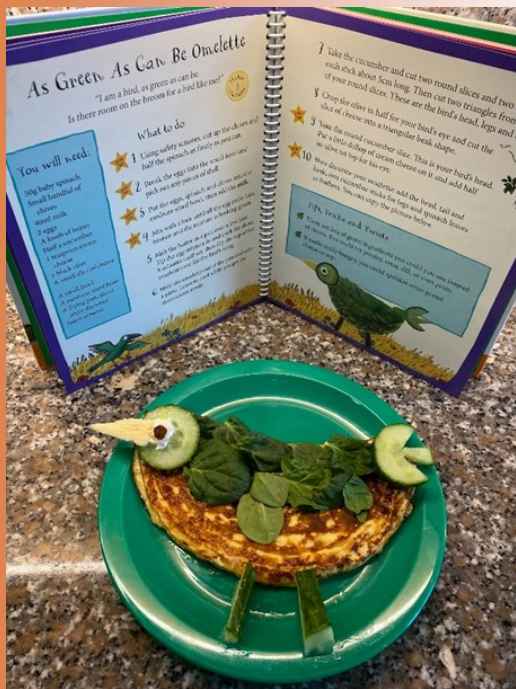


In art at the farm pupils have been working on Giacometti inspired figure sculpture using wire and plaster bandage, decorated with black topped with dry

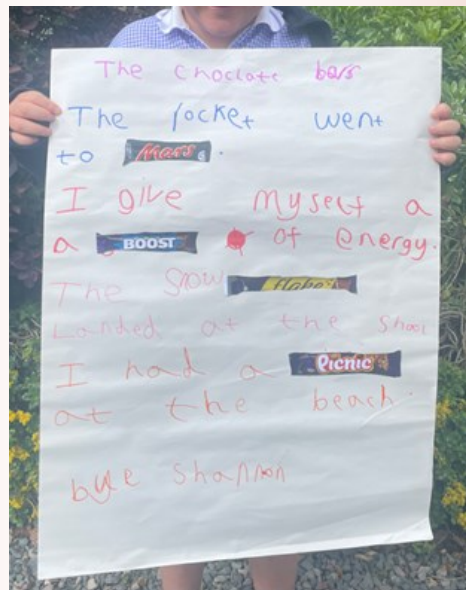


"I am a bird as green as can be, is there room on the broom for a bird like me?" we have made hidden vegetable omelettes to create 'green birds'.
