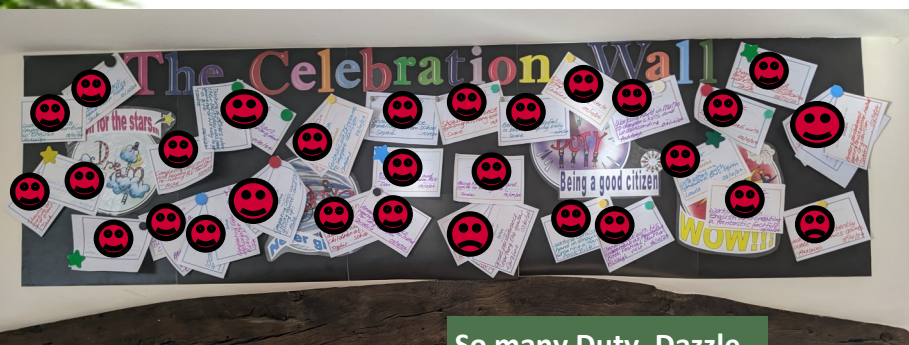
Dec 20th– Last day of Term 2

Oh, imagine them being mine.

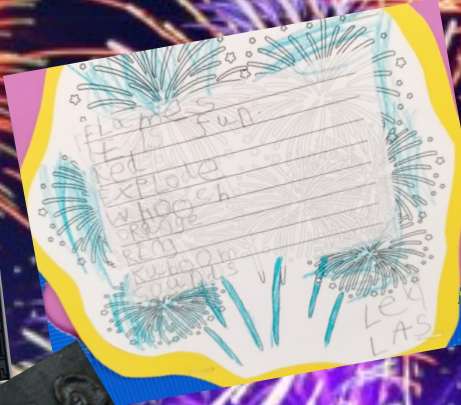

And make a wish I may."



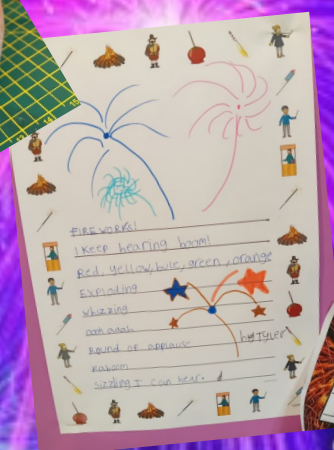
