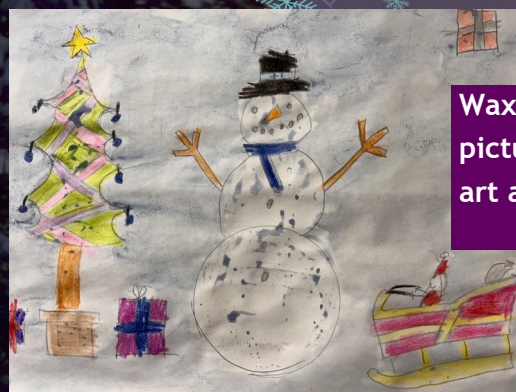
Important dates this term:

Combining our science learning on light with our history learning on WW1 to tell the story of Sergeant Stubby - a WW1 hero!

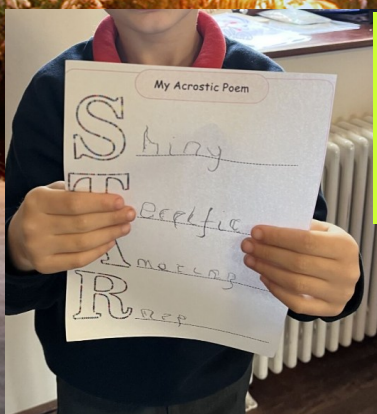

Sensory circuits in the library when the weather is too wet



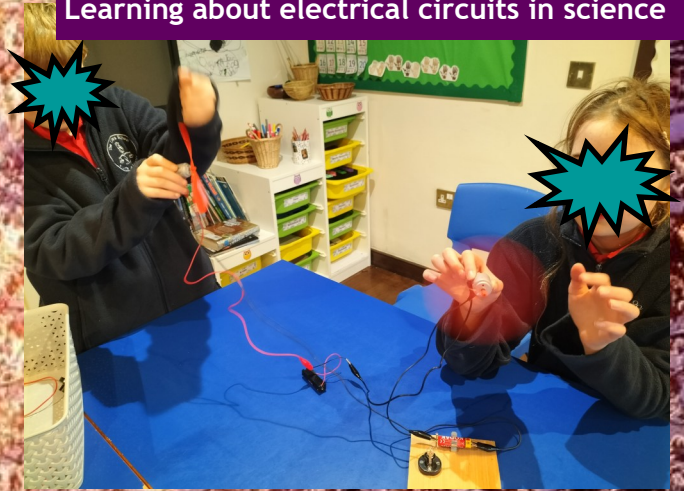

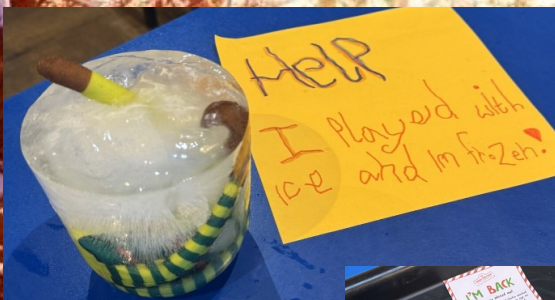
Learning about the Christian creation story in an RE lesson

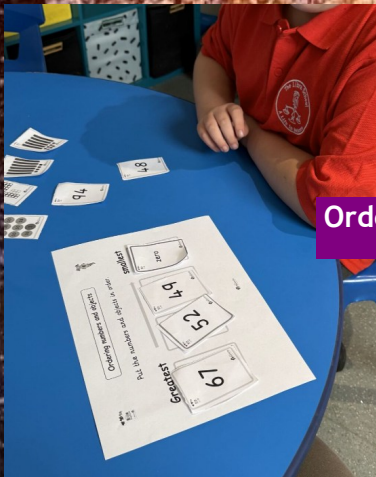

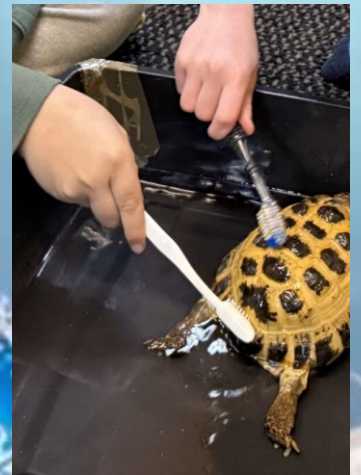
